Students appearing for the 10+2 Science examination through the National Institute of Open Schooling with the same minimum marks are also eligible, provided they are medically fit.

Graduates of the programme will be well-positioned to pursue careers across hospitals, clinics, community health centres, nursing homes, corporate healthcare environments, pharmaceutical companies, and academic institutions. The programme also paves the way for specialisation in fields such as pediatrics, mental health, critical care, and oncology, in addition to opportunities for advanced studies like Master of Science in Nursing (MSN) or Doctor of Nursing Practice (DNP).
